## CHESTER FROST PARK: ORGANIZED FISHING TOURNAMENT PERMIT REGULATIONS

- Park facilities must remain open and available for public use
- Only one (1) fishing tournament permit issued per day
- No fishing tournament permits issued on holidays
- Tournaments must follow all TWRA fishing and boating regulations
- Organizers are responsible for clean-up following weigh-in
- Excessive fish kills are subject to fines or penalties

Day-Tournament participant trailer parking at the boat ramp is limited to 24 spaces + 1 ADA Additional tournament participant trailer parking in designated lots only Night-Tournament participants may utilize entire parking area from 9:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. All Tournament trailer parking is limited to 65 total in Chester Frost Park
